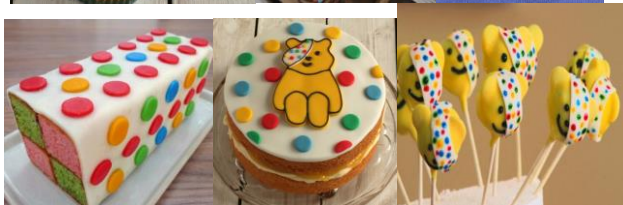
Friday 10th November 2017

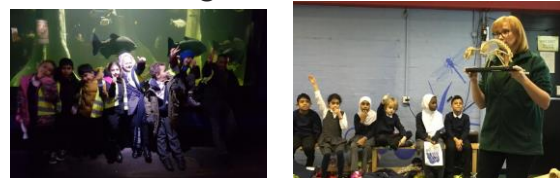
London Zoo visit
