Their hard work was rewarded when it all came together in what was a truly magical performance.

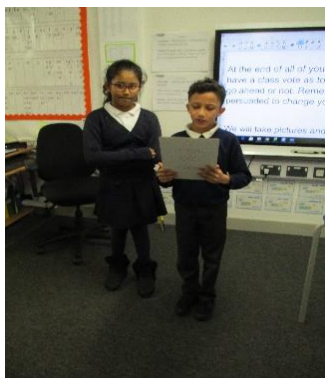
