Attendance Poster Competition

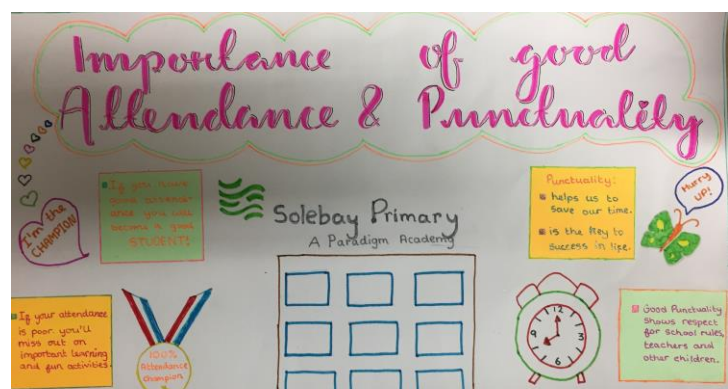
Thank you to all the pupils who entered the attendance poster competition. The standard was extremely high! We are delighted to announce that the winners are as follows:
