Just to keep you updated, due to government advice on 'social distancing' we have decided that we will not be inviting parents and carers into the school for any events or assemblies in the next couple of weeks. We will also not be having whole school assemblies where we are all together in one space. This will just help to keep some distancing between us all.


The school remains open and we will act in accordance with any government guidance which is issued. Government advice is to stay at home for **fourteen days** if you have either a new, 'continuous' cough or a high temperature (37.8 degrees or higher).

We also ask parents and carers to not bring their children to the office in the mornings but to either take them to the line in the Park or wait outside the building, if you are late, and we will collect them from you once all of the other children are inside the building. Again this will help with social distancing.
