Dear parents/ carers,

We have been told by the architect, responsible for the design of our School, that we have not yet met some conditions required by the Planning Department in Tower Hamlets.

I am meeting with an officer from the Transport and Highways Department on Monday morning to find out how we can address the concerns they have raised which are:

- Staggered drop off and collection times;
- The coach and minibus strategy and
- Deliveries.

I shall let you know, as soon as I can, what the outcomes of these discussions are. This will lead on to further conversations, with you all, about the best solution/s to drop off and collection arrangements.

The building contractor, the premises team and I spent two and a half hours yesterday evening identifying all the work/s that need to be completed. The biggest disappointment is the playdeck. It is still not able to be used and it is in an entirely unfinished state – not fit for either the pupils or the staff. I cannot tell you how frustrating this is. We are doing everything we can to resolve the issues.

I hope to see many of you at the Meet The Teacher meetings next week and those of you who have been invited to the meetings about phonics. The children are delighted with their gift of a new book bag; please ensure that the books and bags are brought to School regularly.
