Ruksana Begum Ali



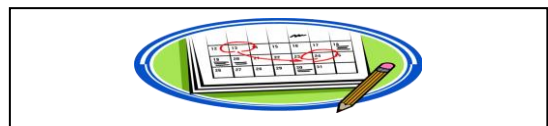
