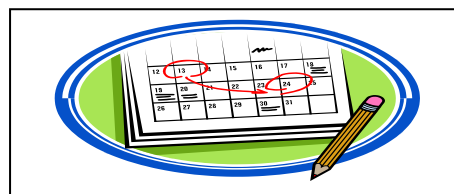
## Cycle path
