Applying for a Nursery place 2015/2016

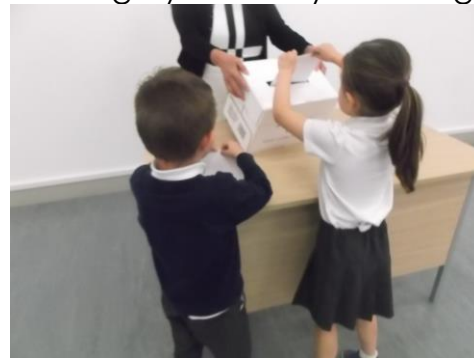
We are pleased to offer full time Nursery places from 1st September 2015. Please request a Nursery application form from the School administration team.

If you know of any families who may be interested in applying for a Nursery place at Solebay Primary Academy, please refer them to the School administration team.

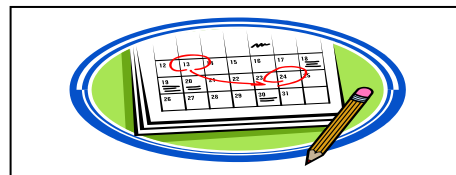
Solebay Election
