

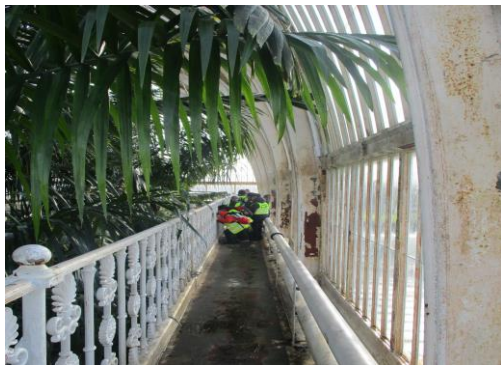

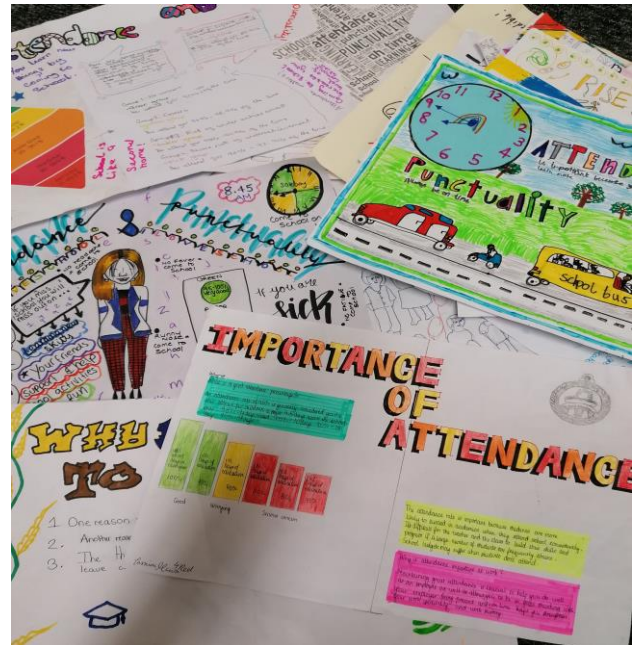


## Unsung Heroes
