Mixed age classes

Y4/5 mixed class and Y5/6 mixed class has been working really well. We have just had assessments and all pupils are doing well. This was the first opportunity to check that the mixed classes are working well.

We have external audits - this term we have had Rob Briscoe looking at the mixed classes and speaking with both class teachers about tracking each pupil to ensure pupils are all reaching year group expectations.

SEND Provision and Safeguarding audits

The outcome was that we provide strong provisions for our pupils and with the arrangements that some pupils work part of the day in the flexi class and part of the day in mainstream they are really developing their social and emotional aspects of learning.

Our Safeguarding audit was also strong. Safeguarding is very effective and this is seen as a priority for our school.

Our mixed class for nursery and reception are working well. All pupils are settled and enjoying their learning.
