## Points of concern:

- A. The plan hasn't started yet and the parent needs to meet with Reine to discuss the plan.

- A. Yes, depending on adult availability it should continue.
- Q. When is parent/teacher consultation?
- A. Jan & May 2026
- Q. Why can't all kids play musical instruments?
- A. Its age dependent due to focus required and other factors.
- Q. Will there be more after school clubs?
- A. it all depends on staffing.
- Q. Are we extending breakfast club?
- A. No, due to ratio required.
